Attached you will find a photograph of the horse.

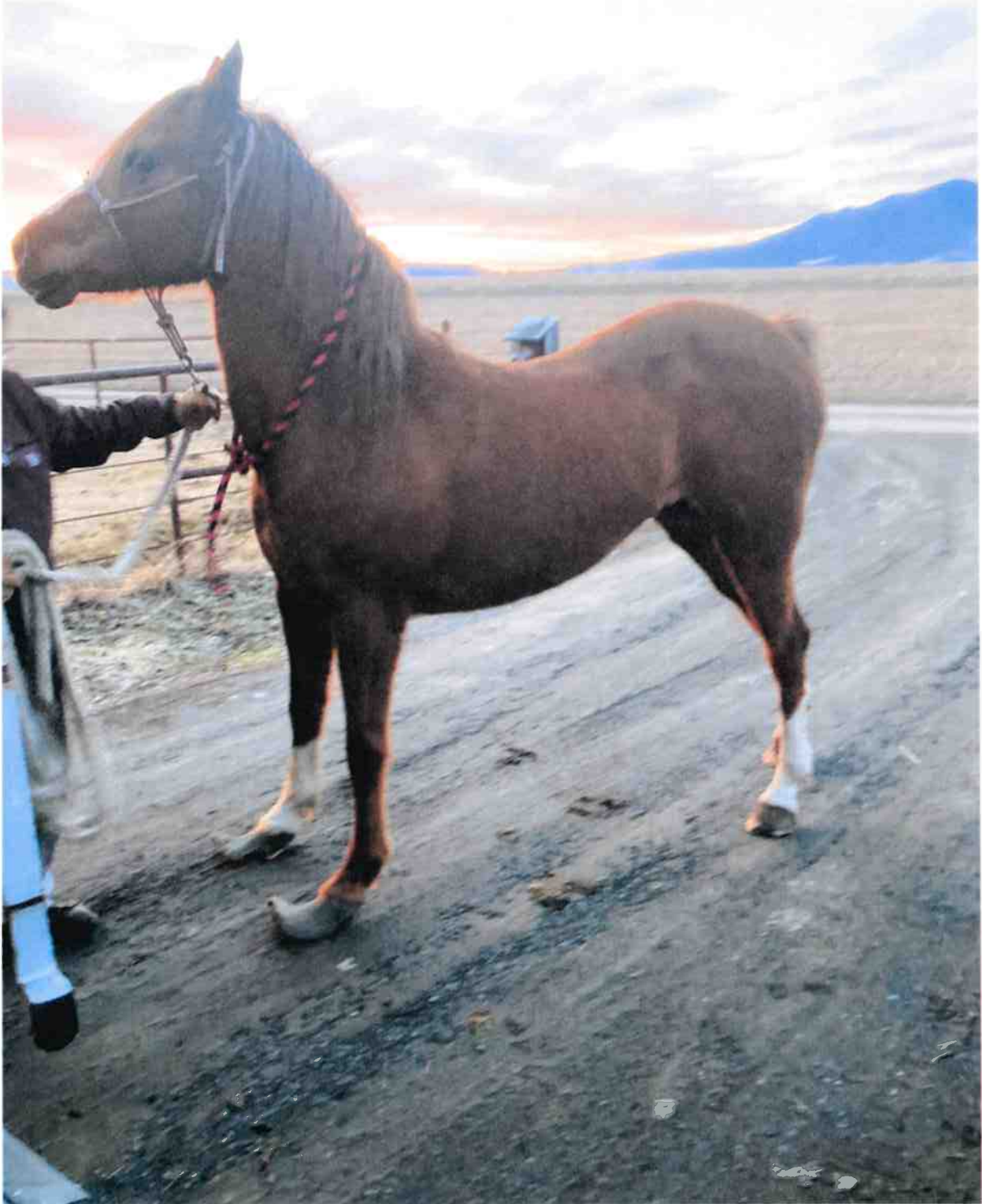
