
Management Representation of Fiscal Affairs Required by Oregon Regulation

The Crook County Vector Control District is subject to, and responsible for, compliance with various laws, rules, and regulations relating to its operation and finances. Among such laws, rules, and regulations are the requirements prescribed in Municipal Audit Law (ORS Chapter 297) and the Minimum Standards for Review of Oregon Municipal Corporations (OAR 162, division 40) including, but not limited to:


- (a) Deposit of public funds with financial institutions (ORS Chapter 295).
- (b) Indebtedness limitations, restrictions, and repayment.
- (c) Budgets legally required (ORS Chapter 294).
- (d) Insurance and fidelity bonds in force or required by law.
- (e) Programs funded from outside sources.
- (f) Highway revenues used for public highways and roads (ORS Chapters 294, 368 & 373).
- (g) Authorized investment of surplus funds (ORS Chapter 294).
- (h) Public contracts, purchasing, and improvements (ORS Chapters 279A, 279B, and 279C).

The management of Crook County Agricultural Extension District is aware of the requirements of Oregon laws and administrative rules concerning each of the above requirements and has complied, in all material respects, with such requirements as of and for the year ended June 30, 2023.
